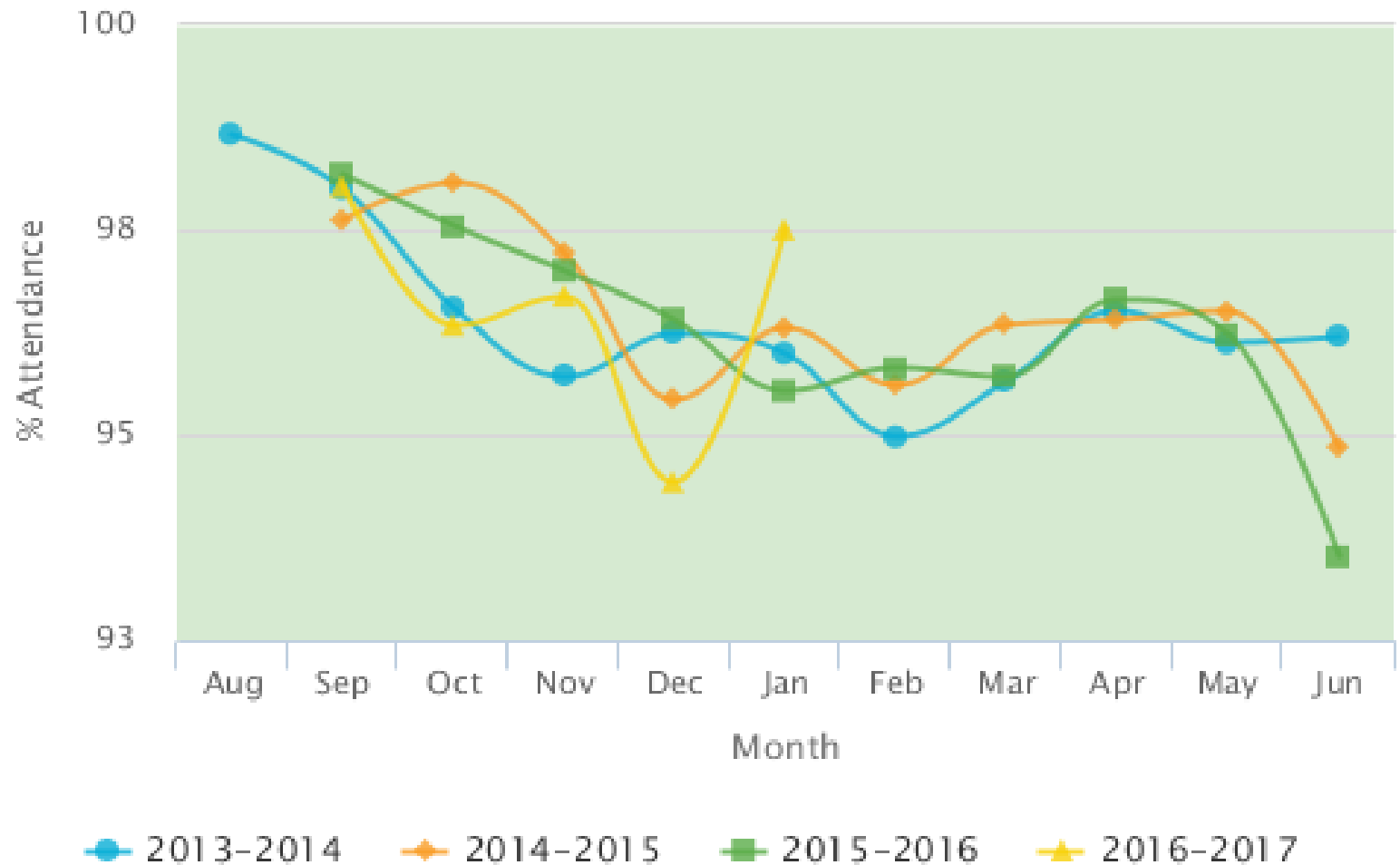

# Professional Development

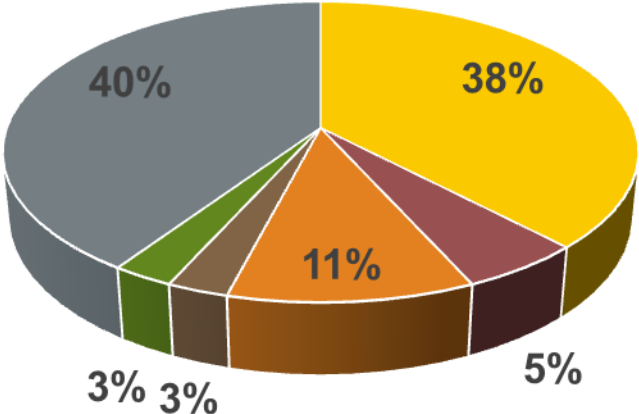

- FOK Fontano's Takeover was Wednesday, January 25. Kellogg staff put in a large order for takeout.

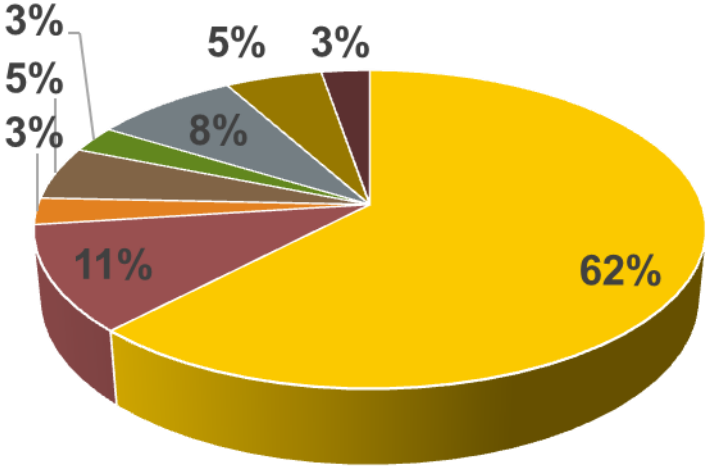
