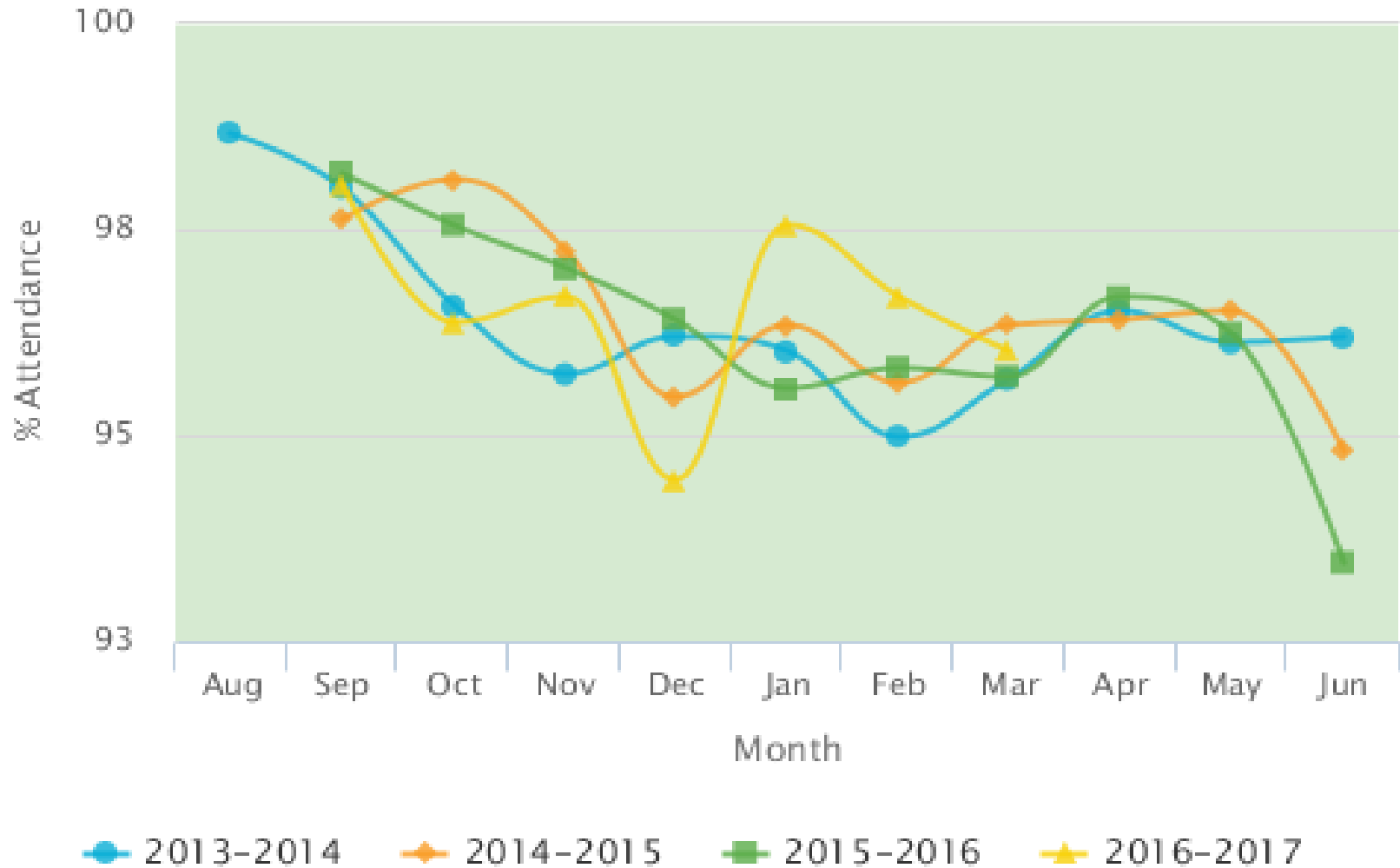

Academics

Professional Development

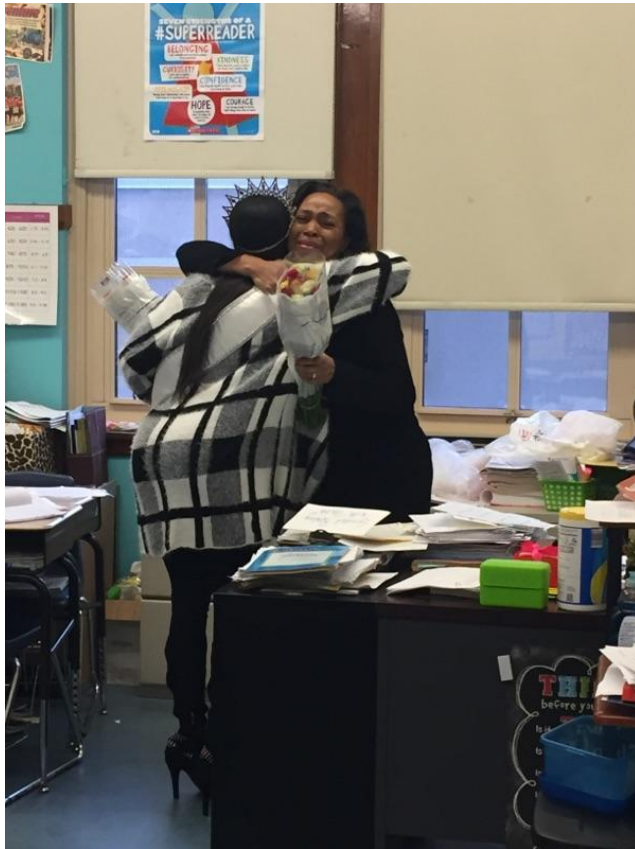
- Mrs. Sutkus and Mrs. Blake attended the Network Math PD.
