

# Kellogg School Uniforms

## 2016-2017

### BOYS

**SHIRT:** White collared shirt, tucked into pants

**PANTS:** Navy pants fitted at waist or belted

**SHOES:** Dress or gym shoes. *Due to safety concerns open toed or open heeled shoes are not permitted*

**SWEATER/FLEECE:** Navy blue or white sweater

### GIRLS

**SHIRT/BLOUSE:** White collared shirt/blouse, tucked into pants/skirt

**PANTS/JUMPER/SKIRT:** Navy pants fitted at waist or belted or navy jumper/skirt

**SHOES:** Dress or gym shoes. *Due to safety concerns open toed or open heeled shoes are not permitted*

**SWEATER/FLEECE:** Navy blue or white sweater

**EARRINGS:** Smaller than a quarter

### Examples of items that are NOT allowed as part of the school uniform:

- No hoodies allowed during the school day. Navy and white hoodies may be worn as outerwear for recess and/or travel to and from school, but must be removed before class begins.
- Piercings (with the exception of earrings smaller than a quarter size for girls) and designs in the hair/eyebrows are not permitted.
- For safety purposes, all chains, necklaces, and necklace type key chains are to worn under the shirt.
- List of common items that are not acceptable, but not an exhaustive list are as follows: flip flops, light up shoes, clogs, sandals, stretch pants, leggings, mid length shirts/sweaters, t-shirts or undershirts (unless they match the uniform colors and are worn under the uniform shirt with no logos), navy pants with strips, cargo pants, windbreaker athletic gear, jeans, bib overalls, or any clothing with holes or tears.

### HOT WEATHER UNIFORM

Students may wear navy blue uniform shorts (no cargo shorts) until October 15<sup>th</sup> and starting May 15<sup>th</sup>.

### GYM UNIFORMS

**SHIRT:** Kellogg navy or yellow t-shirt or plain navy t-shirt

**PANTS:** Kellogg navy blue shorts/sweatpants or plain navy shorts/sweatpants. Shorts to be no shorter than 1 inch above the knee.

**SHOES:** Gym shoes

### DRESS DOWN DAYS

Students must wear appropriate clothes on dress down days. If you question if it is appropriate, then it probably is not.

*\*The following apply to Dress Down Days\**

Students may dress down from the uniform, however they must wear appropriate clothes. Shorts (only allowed during hot weather time) and skirts must be knee length or 1" of the knee, bottoms worn at the waist. Shirts must have sleeves, shirts must meet at the waist and not reveal cleavage, clothing that is torn or has holes is not permitted, clothing with logos, words, or pictures that are not appropriate for a school setting are not permitted.

Appropriate clothing is determined by Administration's discretion.
