December

Schools begin CIWP planning process

Late January-Mid February

Schools receive CPS' initial enrollment projections, submit appeals

Early March

CPS communicates final enrollment projections to schools

March

Ongoing Hyperion training

Early to Mid-April

Principals receive initial school budgets

Late April to Early May

Principals return school budgets and CIWPs and meet with LSCs

Academics

- Teachers are working on submitting 3rd Quarter Unit Plans and Parent Letters
- Teachers are using Google Classroom

- Monthly PD at Merchandise Mart in January, February, March, April, and May to prepare for full implementation in 2018-2019

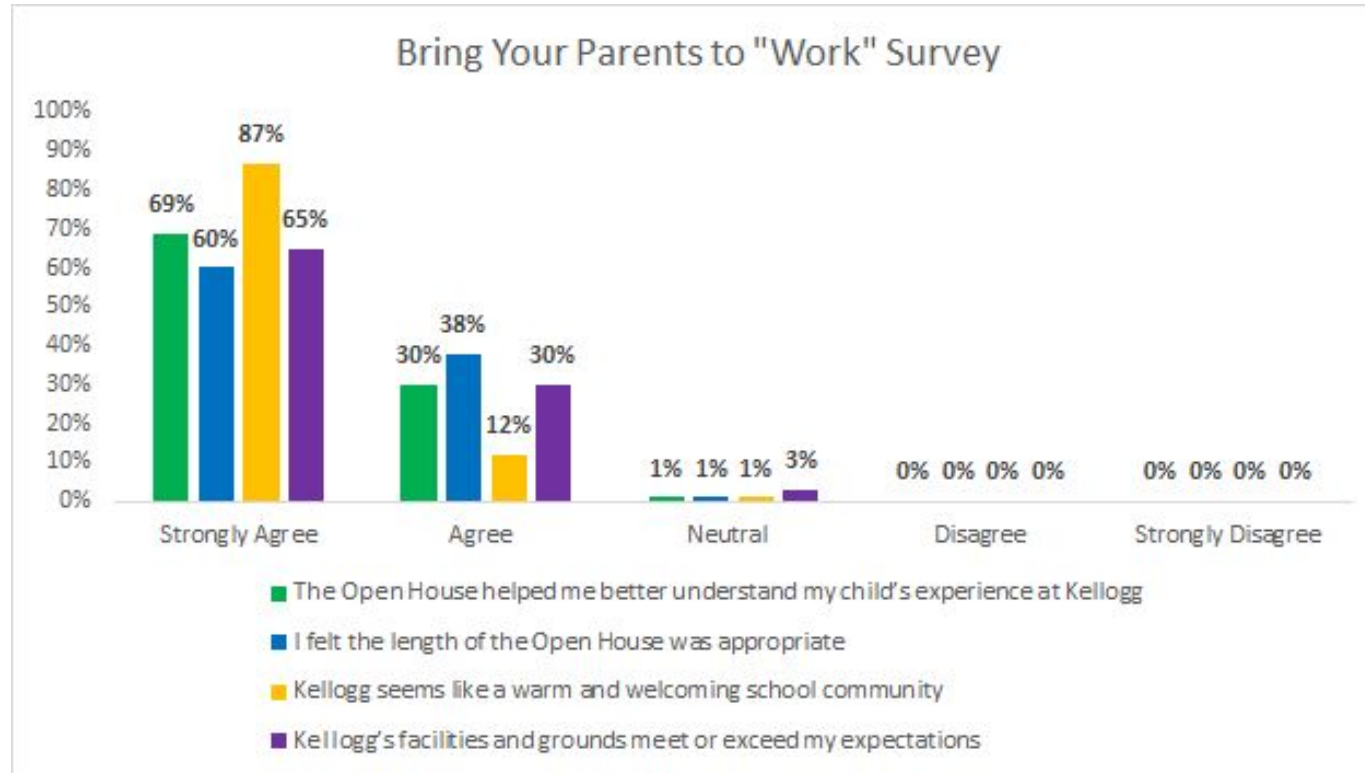

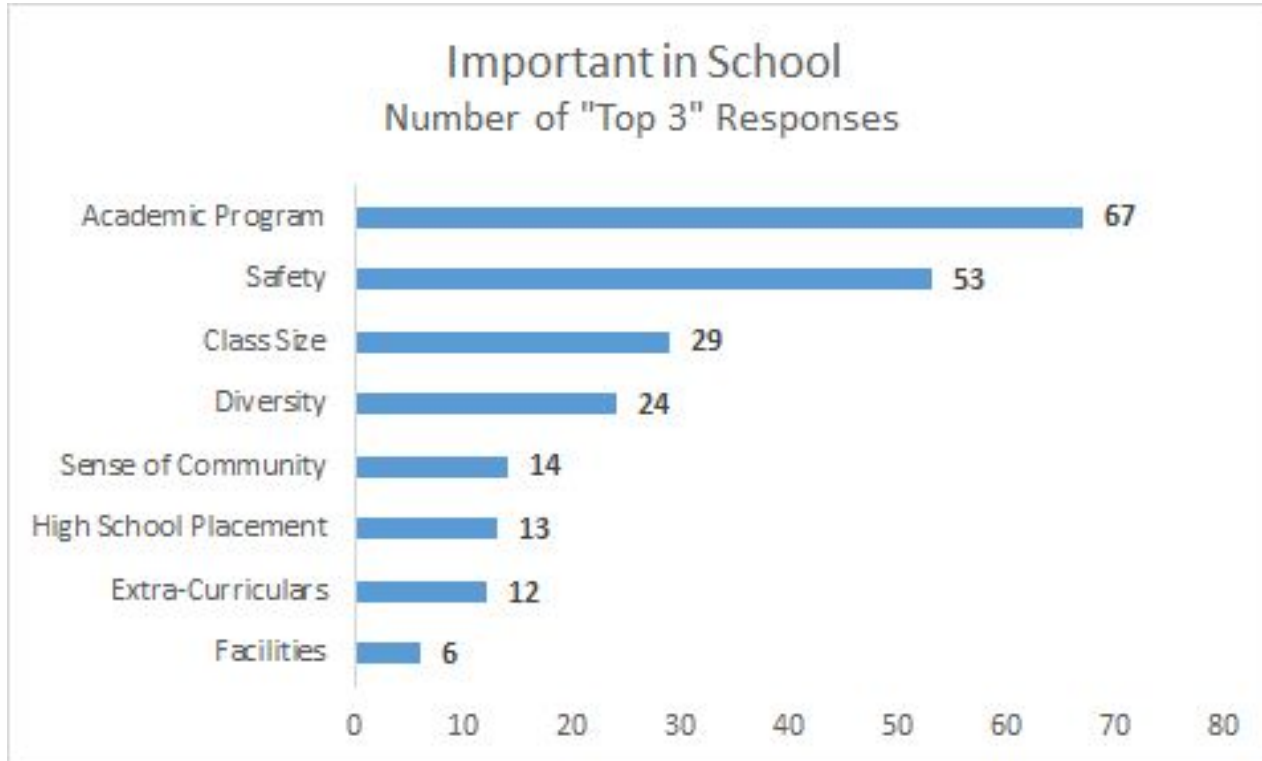
