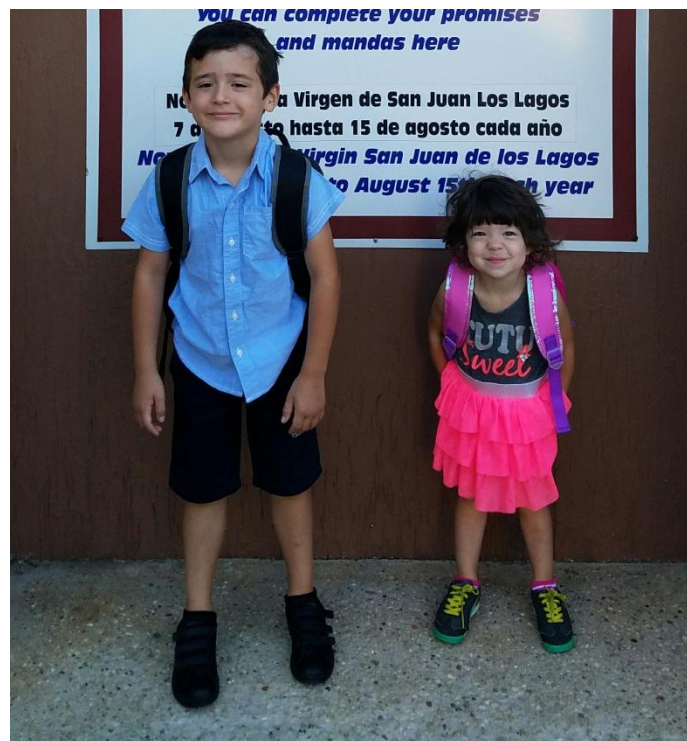

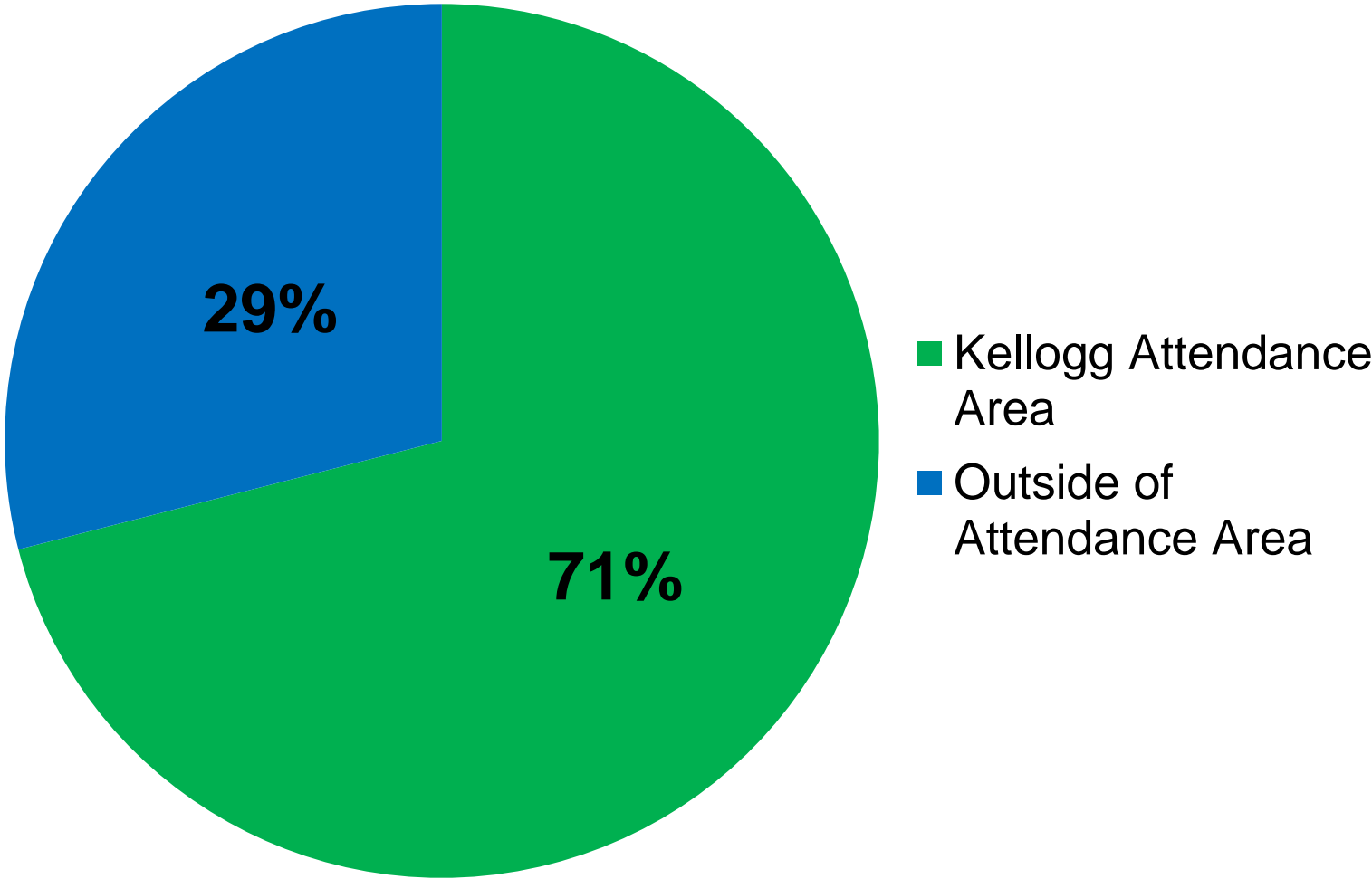

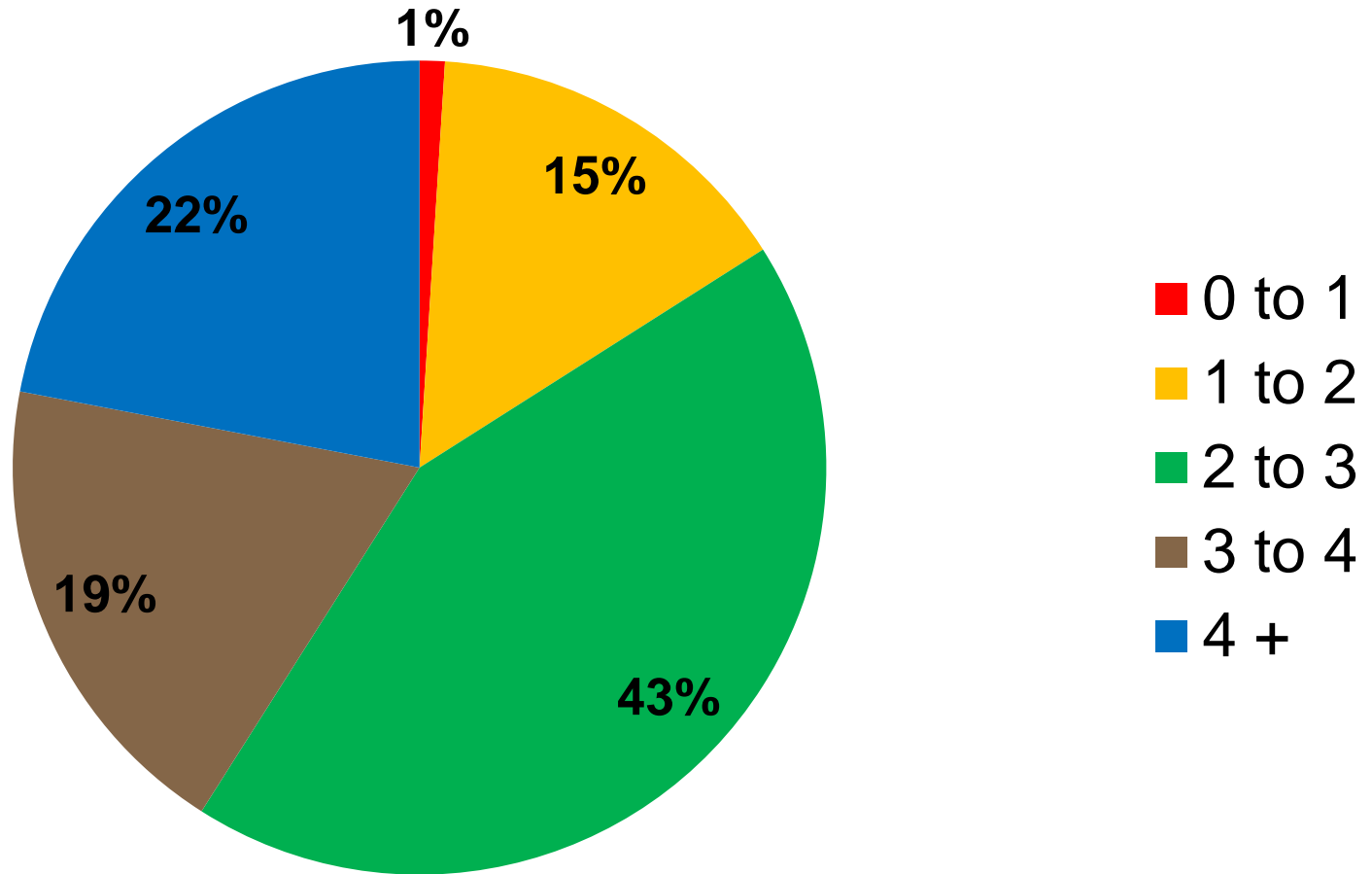


Options for Knowledge

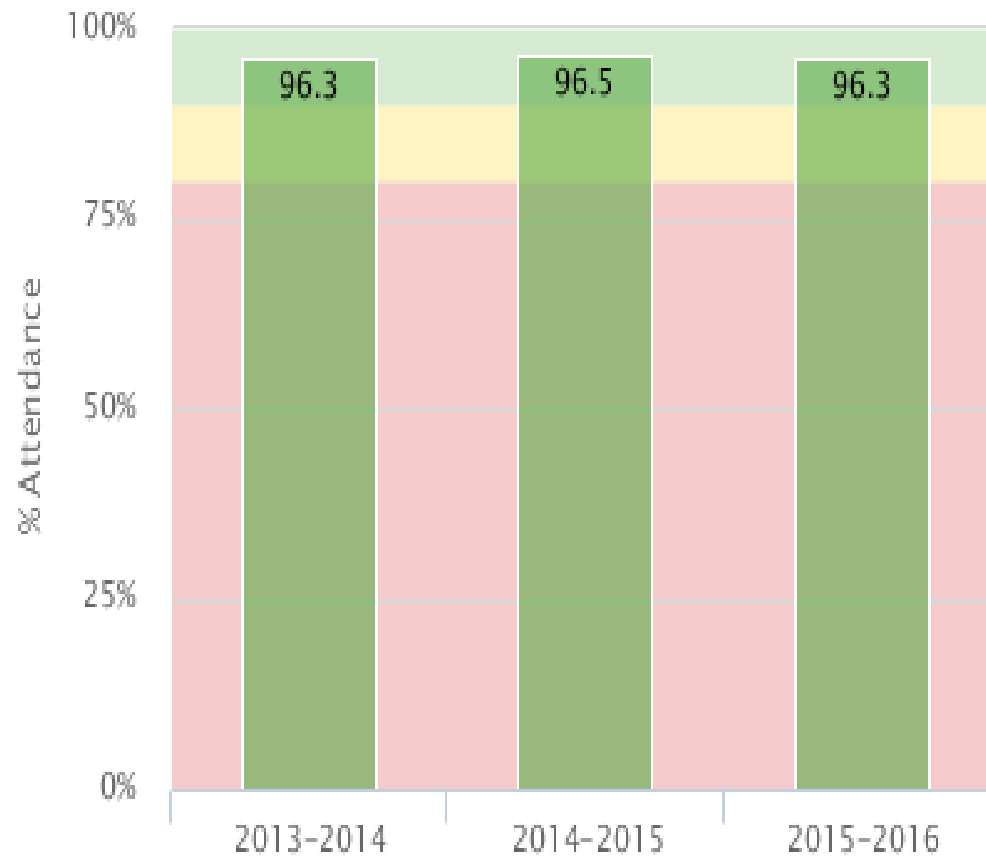

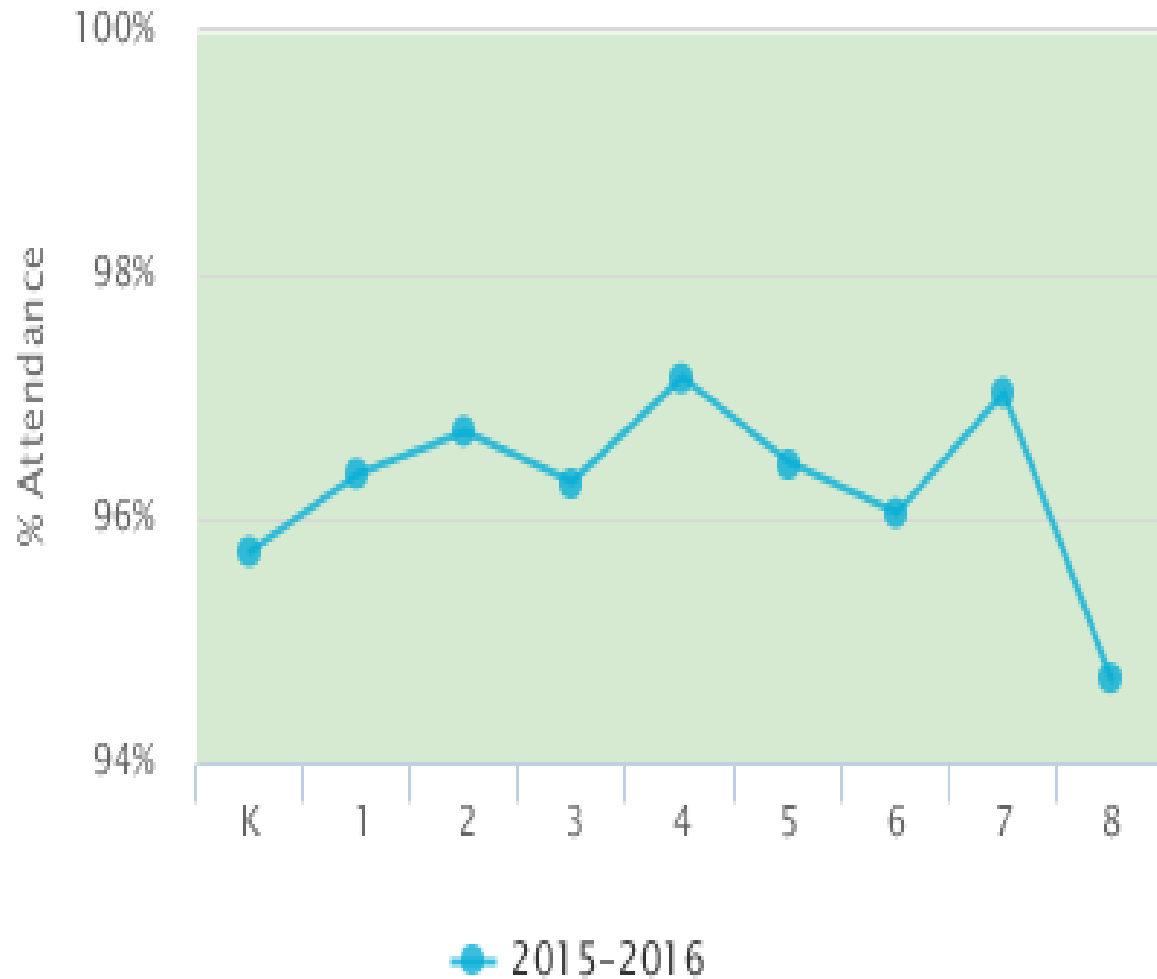
Student Attendance Rate

Student Attendance by Grade

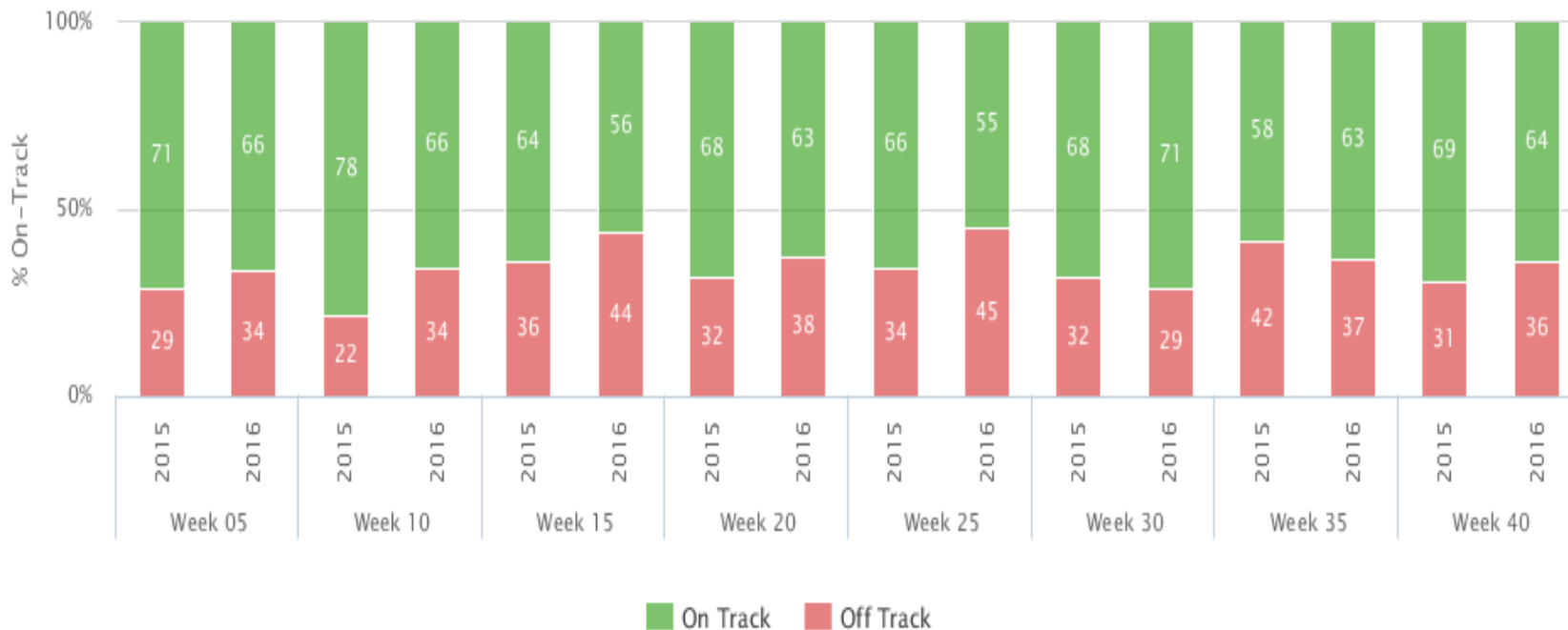

Off Track Break Down

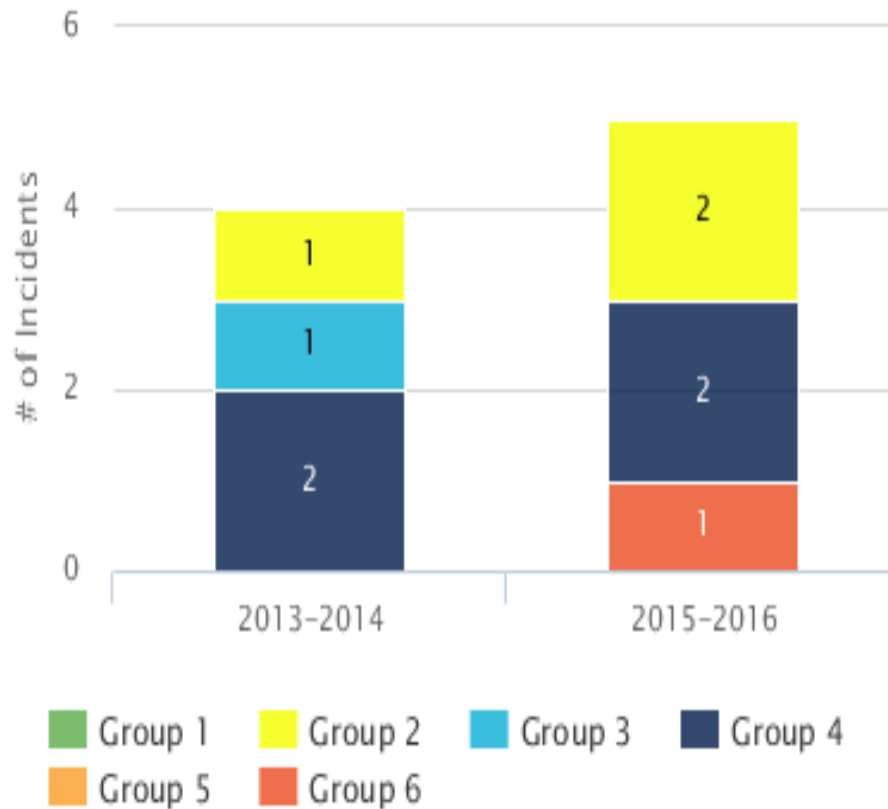

Discipline Misconducts by Group

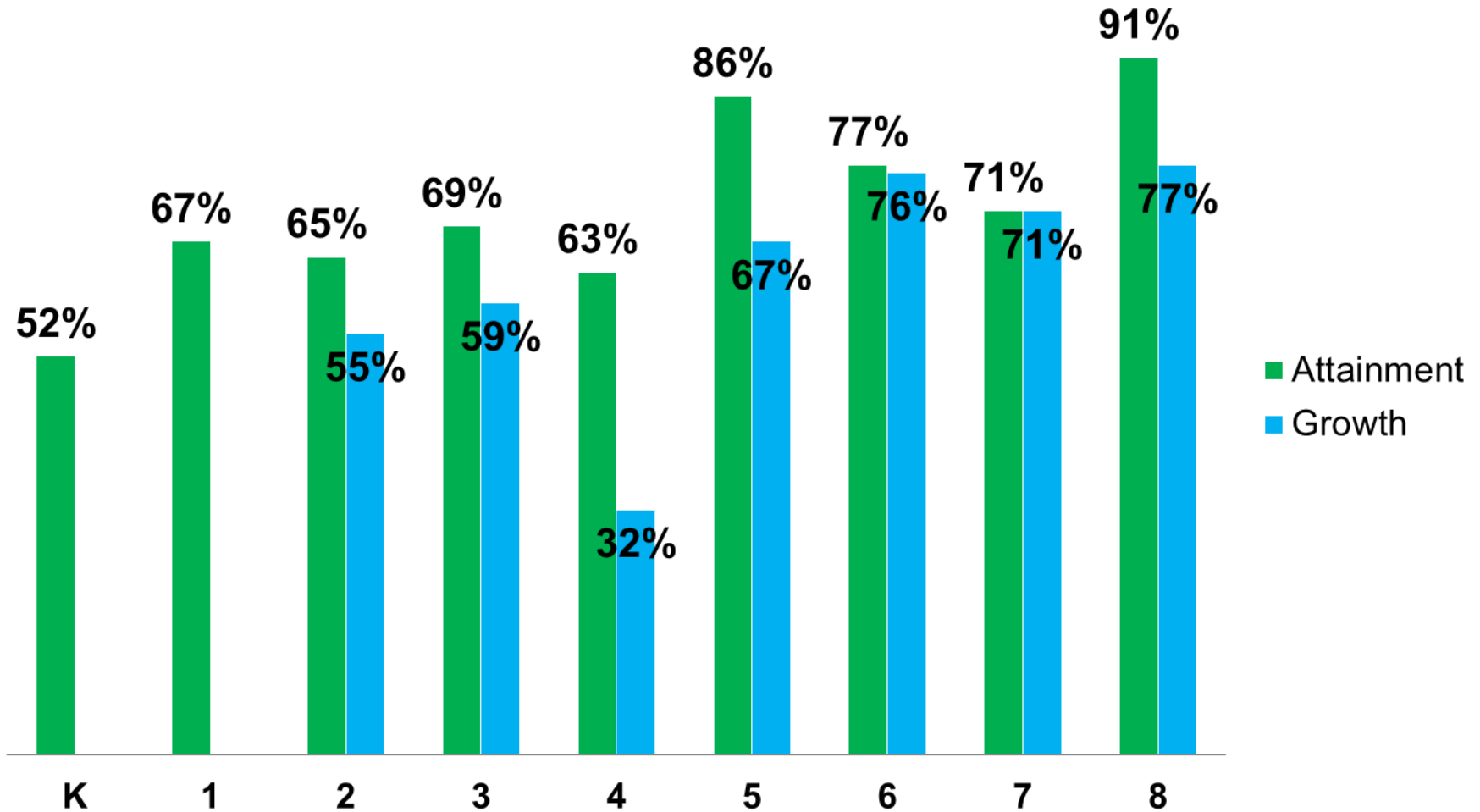

Attainment and Growth

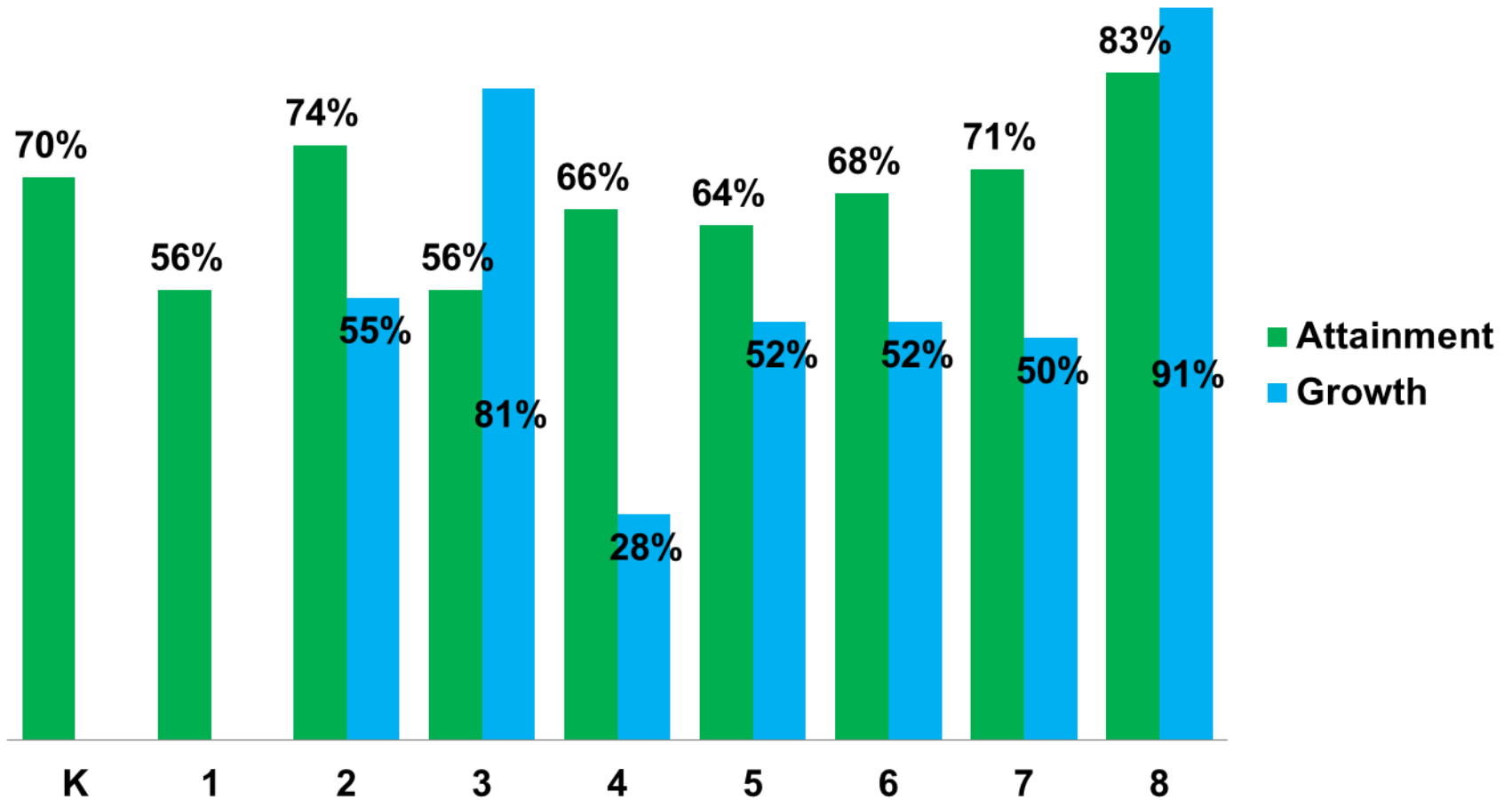
